MARTHA TEICHNER (host) has been a correspondent for *CBS News Sunday Morning* since December 1993. She has won seven Emmy Awards for her work on the broadcast, as well as the James Beard Foundation Special Award for Excellence in Broadcasting in 2002, 2004, 2007, 2009, and 2012. Prior to joining *CBS News Sunday Morning*, Teichner was a CBS News correspondent based in London,

traveling to report stories from the world's hot spots. From 1987 to 1989 she reported from South Africa and then returned for Nelson Mandela's release from prison and his election as president. She also extensively covered the war in Bosnia. In 1991 she was one of the few journalists embedded with U.S. troops in the first Persian Gulf War. In that conflict, she reported from the Saudi desert, from Kuwait after it was liberated, and from Baghdad, as well as Jordan and Israel. Teichner was the first woman correspondent to cover the war in Beirut for CBS News. She joined CBS News as a reporter in the Atlanta bureau in October 1977. A native of Traverse City, Michigan, Teichner received her bachelor's degree in economics from Wellesley College and attended the University of Chicago's Graduate School of Business Administration.
