## WEDNESDAY, JUNE 26: DEPARTURE

Depart for Rome on an overnight flight.

## THURSDAY, JUNE 27: ROME / SPOLETO

Arrive at Rome's Fiumicino airport this morning and drive to Spoleto. Stop for a hearty lunch at a farmhouse-turned-restaurant, which has enchanting views of the verdant hills of southern Umbria. In the afternoon, check in at the gracious Albornoze Palace Hotel. Take a stroll around the city, whose beauty has been praised by many poets and writers including Goethe, Hesse, and even St. Francis. We will also enjoy behind-the-scenes visits to some of the locations of the Festival of Two Worlds. A representative will join us for an informal *aperitivo*, followed by a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. L,R,D

## FRIDAY, JUNE 28: SPOLETO

As the city prepares to host the 62nd edition of Festival of Two Worlds, spend a day discovering its treasures and hidden corners. Set out on a walking tour around Spoleto's alluring medieval alleys, and visit the Archeological Museum and the intimate Roman Theater. Continue to the beautiful Piazza Duomo to see the Romanesque Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta. After lunch visit the Rocca Albornozeana, a 14th-century fortress that dominates the city and houses the Museum of the Duchy. Following a private reception, attend the inaugural contemporary performance *Proserpina* by acclaimed Italian composer Silvia Colasanti. B,L,R

## SATURDAY, JUNE 29 : SPOLETO

This morning, tour Palazzo Collicola, a one-of-a-kind combination of Baroque interior decoration and contemporary art. We will also tour the former house of Gian Carlo Menotti, founder of the Festival of Two Worlds. Then, attend a noontime performance as part of the festival. After lunch, travel to the hills of Montefalco, where the Sagrantino, one of Umbria's most highly acclaimed red wines, is produced. Enjoy an optional visit to a local winery. Return to Spoleto for an evening performance. B,L





## SUNDAY, JUNE 30: SPOLETO / SPELLO / PERUGIA

Depart Spoleto and drive to the peaceful town of Spello. This enchanting medieval hill town boasts splendidly intact town walls and is home to one of Pinturicchio's most joyous and colorful frescoes. After lunch, continue to Perugia, the capital of Umbria. Check in at the hotel, surrounded by the beautiful green countryside, before gathering for dinner this evening. B,L,D

## MONDAY, JULY 1: PERUGIA

Once an Etruscan settlement, Perugia is a lively and cosmopolitan city. Today embark on an exciting walking tour to discover its rich heritage and experience its vibrant atmosphere. Start with the Umbrian National Gallery, a superb collection of Renaissance paintings including works by Piero della Francesca, Pinturicchio, Beato Angelico, and Benozzo Gozzoli. Continue to the Collegio del Cambio to admire the extraordinary frescoes by Pietro Vannucci, also known as Perugino. Then see the celebrated Fontana Maggiore and the little Church of San Severo. Conclude with a private visit to an artist's workshop. Return to the hotel for an evening at leisure. B,L

## TUESDAY, JULY 2: PERUGIA / ASSISI / SOLOMEO

This morning an optional visit to Assisi, the pink-stone town famous as the home of St. Francis, is arranged. Admire the priceless frescoes by Giotto in the St. Francis Basilica and visit the Church of Santa Clara. In the afternoon, explore idyllic Solomeo. The acclaimed Umbrian designer Brunello Cucinelli has been restoring this small town, where his eponymous company is located, for the past 30 years. Accompanied by a representative from the fashion house, tour the factory and visit the School of Arts and Crafts, the Cucinelli Theater, and the vineyards. This evening enjoy a lively farewell dinner. B,L,D

## WEDNESDAY, JULY 3: PERUGIA / RETURN

Bid farewell to Umbria early this morning and transfer to Rome Fiumicino airport for your flights home. B

### ALBORNOZ PALACE HOTEL
