Artist Services Assistant

The Artist Services Assistant is a full-time, seasonal position that provides support in the Artistic Planning and Operations Department. This person will work directly with Festival Company Manager and Producing Associate to plan and coordinate logistics related to the hundreds of artists who perform at the festival.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide administrative and operations support to the Artist Services department
- Assist with coordination of artist housing
- Plan and coordinate artist welcome hospitality
- Assist with logistics related to festival artists
- Coordinate transportation scheduling including overseeing vehicle rentals and Festival drivers

Extensive evening and weekend time commitment is essential beginning in May through the run of the Festival; must be willing to be on call around the clock during this period.

Qualifications:

- Strong communication skills, both verbal and written
- Exceptional attention to detail
- Computer skills as they relate to organizational tasks, especially knowledge of Microsoft Excel and Outlook
- The ability to think fast and problem solve in a highly pressured, fast-paced environment

Compensation: All seasonal positions with the Festival start at \$15/hour.
